


Unifor Atlantic Communication Locals



For Decades, Bell Canada has taken advantage of employees hard work and loyalty. Bargaining unit work has been snatched away though non-union outsourcing, contracting out, and job erosion across Bell units.

2600 Jobs lost in Atlantic Canada in the last 15 years!

While we have been shrinking, non-unionized jobs at Bell have been growing. In 2009 Bell had 50,600 employees now they have 53,000 in 2019. These are union busting tactics that can no longer be tolerated.

What does it mean to me as a unionized worker & as a consumer?

Bell has increased contractors here in Canada and offshore. They have moved to other countries to
