Dear Brother and Sisters,

We are monitoring the COVID-19 situation, working with the Health and Safety Committee and are in constant communication with CMBC's Safety Environment and Emergency Management Department. There is a lot of uncertainty and fear with this virus and we will do everything we can to make sure our members are informed with the most accurate information.

On March 10th, 2020, we requested the Safety data sheet and the disinfectant Decon7 is being used. This disinfectant dries within a short period of time and is only airborne during the application process. This product has been approved for these types of applications and is being used by a number of different transit agencies across North America.

Should there be any risk to your safety, we will advise CMBC and work to rectify the situation immediately. We ask our members to be patient as this situation is evolving hourly. We will provide information as soon as it is made available.

Although we are disinfecting the buses regularly, you should still:

- Wash hands often with soap and water
- Avoid physical contact with others
- Do not touch your eyes, mouth or nose with unwashed hands
- Be aware that hand sanitizers must be more than 60% alcohol in order to kill viruses
