Mandatory Screening Health Order

Sisters & Brothers,

Starting November 11, 2020, the government issued a mandatory screening health order for the workplace. CMBC will be asking our member's health related questions to help slow the spread of COVID-19.

1. Are you experiencing any new-onset symptoms of COVID-19?
2. Have you travelled outside of Canada, including the United States, within the last 14 days?
3. Have you been in close contact with someone who has confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis within the last 14 days.
4. Have you been told to self-isolate in accordance with Public Health directives?

If you answer yes to any of these questions, you are asked to leave the workplace and call 811 for further instructions. On the road reliefs, either call TComm or send TComm canned COVID-19 message.

CMBC says they will not track or record any of these daily health screening questions.
